Dependent Children

A maximum of thirty-four (34) scholarships of up to \$5,000

Del A. Weber Scholarship

(Dependent Children Attending Continuation High School/
Alternative Education Programs)

A maximum of one (1) scholarship of up to \$5,000

Members

A maximum of five (5) scholarships of up to \$3,000

L. Gordon Bittle Memorial Scholarship for Student CTA (SCTA)

A maximum of three (3) scholarships of up to \$3,000

Dependent

- A maximum of thirty-four (34) scholarships of up to \$5,000 are awarded.
- The Ralph J. Flynn Memorial Fund provides the scholarship for the highest scoring applicant.
- Applicant must be the dependent child of an active, retired or deceased CTA member and be claimed as dependent status on the current year's IRS form.
- High school grade point average should reflect a high unweighted average. College coursework should reflect high academic achievement. Explain any special circumstances related to medical, physical or emotional difficulties that may have affected your grades.

Del A. Weber Scholarship

- A maximum of one (1) scholarship of up to \$5,000 is awarded.
- Applicant must be the dependent child of an active, retired or deceased CTA member and be claimed as dependent status on the current year's IRS form.
- High school grade point average should reflect at least a 2.0 average.

Members

- A maximum of five (5) scholarships of up to \$3,000 are awarded.
- Applicant must be a current "active" member of CTA (including members working on an emergency credential).
- College coursework should demonstrate high academic achievement. Explain any unique circumstances related to medical, physical or emotional difficulties that may have affected your grades.

Note: ESP applicants refer to the applicant's statement directions (page 3 of application)

L. Gordon Bittle Memorial Scholarship for Student CTA

- A maximum of three (3) scholarships of up to \$3,000 are awarded.
- High school grade point average should reflect a high unweighted average. College coursework should reflect high academic achievement. Explain any unique circumstances related to medical, physical or emotional difficulties that may have affected your grades.

Evaluation of Applications

1. Scholarships are awarded based on:
 - Applicant's Statement 30 pts
 - School and Community Activities 20 pts 50%
 - Letter of Recommendation #1 25 pts
 - Letter of Recommendation #2 25 pts 50%

100 pts

 - Points will be deducted if the guidelines are not followed.
2. Letters of recommendation must separately address each of the following categories:
 - Involvement in and sensitivity to human, social and civic issues that reflect responsibility, reliability and integrity.
 - Educational and personal achievements that reflect academic and vocational potential.
3. Applications are read in their entirety by a team of judges. The applications with the highest cumulative scores are chosen as scholarship recipients.
4. Scholarship applicants are notified by mail in May. In order to receive funds, scholarship recipients will be required to submit proof of registration for the summer or fall 2012 semester/quarter as:
 - A full-time student in an accredited institution of higher learning; or
 - Registered in an approved credential or degree program in an accredited institution of higher learning.
 - Registered in an approved technical training or certificate program if the applicant is an ESP member.
